**General Description of Duties** | A professional, sworn position that performs law enforcement and crime prevention work, including patrol and investigation; apprehension of criminals, preservation of peace, and protection of life and property; enforces federal state and local laws; practices the principles of community policing; does related work as required

Experience and Training | High school diploma or equivalent supplemented by college level coursework; some experience in law enforcement military or other fields (i.e. psychology social service customer service) that demonstrates desired knowledge skills and abilities; OR any equivalent combination of education training and experience that provides the knowledge skills and abilities required to perform the work will be considered

**Necessary Special Requirements** | Be at least 21 years of age by the date of appointment process; be able to obtain a valid state of Oregon driver's license; have a safe driving record; be a United States citizen at time of appointment; be able to possess a basic certificate from the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) with 12 months of employment; be in good physical and mental health as determined by a medical and psychological examination; must pass an extensive background investigation and be free a felony conviction.
