Explanation of Cemetery Maps

Odd Fellows sections – one lot contains five graves

Masonic sections – one lot contains 10 graves

North Annex – various numbers of graves per lot

Numerical order of graves – the graves are numbered 1 through 5 or 1 through 10 going from north to south (top to bottom – grave #1 is at north end and grave #5 is at south end)

M – appearing in the top right corner indicates there is a marker on that particular gravesite

V – appearing in the upper right corner indicates the deceased was a veteran*

ZZZZ – indicates grave is apparently vacant

Last name only – indicates ownership of that grave space (If there is a first initial with a last name, there is a person buried in that space.)

Unknown or Unknown [name] – space is occupied
