**Public Notice: Type IV – Public Hearing
Official Street Name Change**

Project Name: **Alley Naming Project**

You are provided this notice because the City is proposing public and private alley name changes near your property in Hillsboro, Oregon. **A public hearing will be held before the City Council through a Zoom virtual meeting at or shortly after 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, November 17, 2020. Instructions on how to join the Zoom teleconference meeting are provided in this notice.**

Request: The City of Hillsboro Planning Division is requesting that the City Council, through an Official Street Name Change application, name currently unnamed public and private alleys that are located within the City limits of Hillsboro. The purpose of the request is to reduce confusion in the street grid for emergency responders as well as an important step in the broader effort in meeting the Hillsboro 2020 Vision Action Plan goal of establishing a common Hillsboro address for the entirety of the city. Maps that show the affected alleys and the proposed names are attached for reference.

ORS 227.120 and Municipal Code Chapter 9.24 set forth the procedure and approval process for naming or renaming streets. The Planning Commission has recommended to the City Council that the renaming is in the best interest of the City. On October 20, 2020, the City Council is scheduled to set the public hearing date on this request for November 17, 2020.

The staff report on this matter will be available on Tuesday, November 10th at 4:00 p.m. The staff report and the applicable criteria are available for public inspection at no cost, or copies can be provided at reasonable cost, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. weekdays, excluding holidays, in the Planning Department at the Civic Center, 150 E Main Street, 4th floor, Hillsboro, Oregon.

All interested persons are invited to attend this virtual Zoom meeting (instructions below) and will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning the proposal. Testimony can be provided during the meeting via teleconference or submitted in writing prior to the meeting.

Written Testimony: Email aubrey.minear@hillsboro-oregon.gov before 8 am on Tuesday, November 10th to provide written testimony. The agenda packet will be updated after 8 am with the testimony received via email.

Teleconference Testimony: Pre-register to speak during the public hearing by providing your name and phone number, or Zoom name, to the City Recorder's Office before 8 am on Tuesday, November 17th. During the public hearing, the Mayor will read down the list of those who pre-registered. When the Mayor calls out your name, you will have three minutes to speak. Members of the public using Zoom will not be able to share their screen during the meeting; presentation materials should be submitted as written testimony. You can pre-register by emailing aubrey.minear@hillsboro-oregon.gov or calling 503-681-6269. Testimony should avoid repetition of issues, and should be based on the application or on the approval criteria listed above. ORS 197.763 provides that under certain circumstances, the record may remain open or a continuance may be granted upon the request of a participant. Telephone conversations cannot be accepted as testimony. Please reference the Case File No. on all written testimony.
