

Safe Routes to School

Scavenger Hunt and Raffle

In December 2020 and the first week of January 2021, the City of Hillsboro Safe Routes to School program hosted its first virtual SRTS Scavenger Hunt & Raffle for students living in Hillsboro or going to Hillsboro School District schools. The event was open for students in grades Kindergarten through eighth grade and there were participants from every grade.

Students participated in this event by finding at least 6 of the 8 items on their scavenger hunt activity sheet, drawing a picture of the most interesting thing they saw on their walk, and submitting a photo of their completed form on our website or mailing it to the City. The items on the scavenger hunt were of photos taken in Hillsboro, and focused on items that each child might be able to find in their own neighborhood. The goal of this activity was to encourage students to stay active while learning remotely.

Once the event closed, staff randomly selected a raffle winner from the completed activity sheets.

To show the City's appreciation for their efforts during this extraordinary time, participants who provided an address received a thank you letter and stickers.
