SURVEY OVERVIEW

The Oak/Baseline/10th Avenue project is identifying opportunities for improvements along this frequently used corridor. After hearing from the community, the project team created four design concepts to improve the walkability, livability and vibrancy of Downtown.

The design alternatives aim to:

- Increase safety for people walking, biking, rolling, and accessing transit.
- Improve connections to the surrounding neighborhoods and existing community destinations.



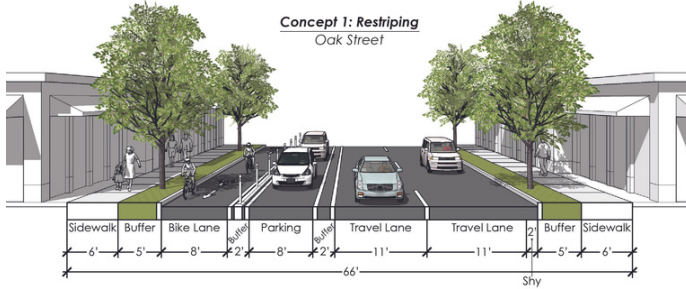

BASELINE ST. CONCEPT FEEDBACK



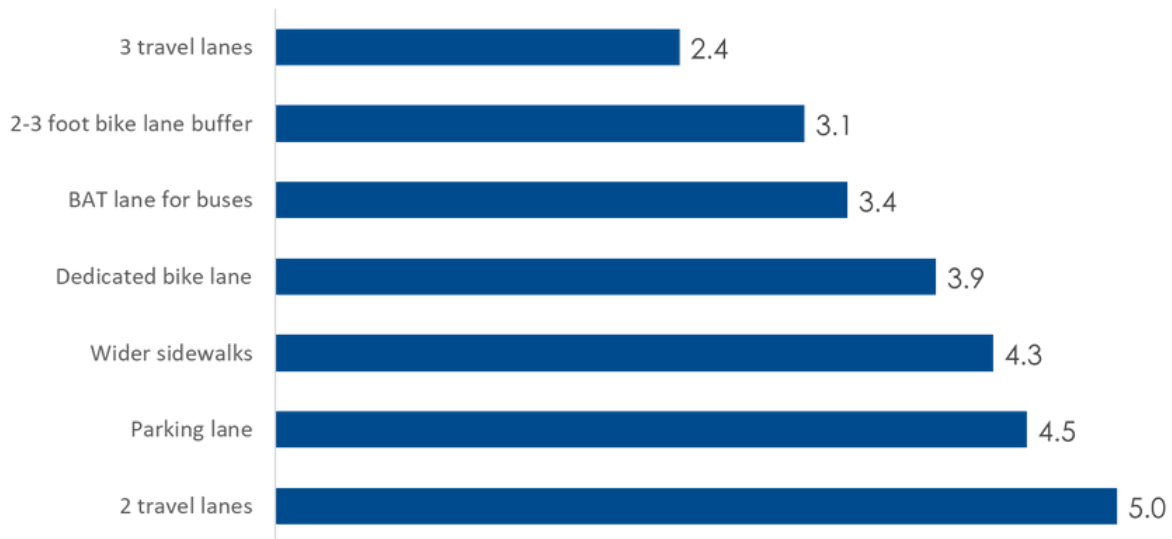
