## SURVEYOVERVIEW

The Oak/Baseline/10th Avenue project is identifying opportunities for improvements along this frequently used corridor.

The project is studying how people, and goods, move around - and through - Downtown Hillsboro. As well as how this movement affects the character of the community, economic development and natural resources.



#### The Concept Plans aim to:


- Increase safety for people walking, biking, rolling, and accessing transit.
- Improve connections to the surrounding neighborhoods and existing community destinations.





#### **BASELINE STREET**





1. Survey takers' frequency of using OR 8: Oak/Baseline/10th Avenue.




2. How well do the preferred concepts improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians in the area?



IMPROVE SAFETY

BUILD BETTER CONNECTIONS



Integrate the couplet with the rest of Downtown, rather than it being a barrier to accessibility.

EXPLORE TREATMENT OPTIONS



Evaluation of realistic, effective OR 8 treatments that match the corridor vision, meet Project goals, and align with the urban context of each unique segment.

ENHANCE ENVIRONMENT
